Name	Pronunciation	Role
Oedipus	Ee-dip-uss	Previous ruler to Eteocles
Antigone	Anti-gone-ee	Protagonist
Creon	Cree-on	Antigone's Uncle (now king)
Eteocles	Et-ee-oh-clees	Antigone's Brother (was king)
Polynices	Poly-nice-ees	Antigone's Brother (not buried)
Ismene	Is-men-ee	Antigone's sister
Haemon	Hay-mon	Creon's Son
Tiresias	Ti-ress-i-as	A blind Prophet
Eurydice	You-rid-i-see	Creon's Wife



Structure of Greek Tragedy:

Section	What happens?
Prologue	Start of the performance
Parados	Entrance of the characters
Episode	The scene of the performance
Stasimon	The chorus repeat the content of the scene in rhyme and ask questions
Exodus	The finish and exit

Theatre Terms:

Technical Term	What it is
Lighting	The colour of the lighting, what it shines on and its intensity (really light or dimmed)
Sound	Anything that you can hear. Music, Sound effects, noise.
Costume	What is worn by characters on stage. Made from different materials.
Set	Furniture or materials on stage which provide the audience with a sense of location.
Make-up	Coloured creams, powders and lotions applied to the skin to change someone's appearance.
