1. The near future tense uses the verb *aller* (to go) plus an infinitive:-

- je vais = I am going*
- tu vas = you are going*
- il va = he is going*
- elle va = she is going*
- on va = we are going*
- nous allons = we are going*
- vous allez = you are going*
- ils vont = they are going*
- elles vont = they are going*



- Faire = to do/make**
- Aller = to go**
- Porter = to wear**
- Se disputer = to argue**
- S'entendre avec = to get on with**
- Lire = to read**
- S'amuser = to have fun**
- Venir = to come**

Using three tenses (present, perfect and near future)

In order to attain a higher level in your written and spoken work, you need to show that you can use different tenses together.

present

D'habitude, **je mange** des céréales au petit déjeuner, mais hier, **j'ai mangé** des œufs et demain, **je vais manger** du bacon.

perfect near future

Translation = Usually, I eat some cereal at breakfast, but yesterday, I ate some eggs and tomorrow, I am going to eat some bacon.

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You use prepositions to describe where things are.

<i>dans</i>	in	<i>entre</i>	between
<i>devant</i>	in front of	<i>sous</i>	under
<i>derrière</i>	behind	<i>sur</i>	on

entre la cuisine et le salon
between the kitchen and the living room

sur la table on the table

Some prepositions are followed by **de**.

- à côté de* next to
- à droite de* on the right of
- à gauche de* on the left of
- en face de* opposite

Remember: *de + le* → *du*

à côté du salon

en face de la salle de bains
