

# Dressed for Success

## at John Port Spencer Academy

### Aims

- To get students to take pride in their appearance and wear the correct uniform in the correct way.
- To reward well-dressed students.
- To promote community.

### The basics

- Students are aware of clear expectations with regard to uniform and appearance. Posters are placed around the school with clear rules.
- Any instance of a student not adhering to these expectations will result in a behaviour (uniform/jewellery) point being placed on SIMS.
- Students accruing no points will be given achievement points (D4S).
- A league table will be published weekly of tutor groups and year groups. The tutor group at the top of the league table for that year group will receive a reward.
- Prize draws will be carried out weekly for all students with no uniform points in a tutor group.

### How it will work

- Staff will give students a Uniform/Jewellery point for any uniform infringements.
- Uniform infringements will also be dealt with in the usual way e.g. asking students to tuck shirts in, hide jewellery, etc. There will still be a point allocated.
- If students rectify their uniform without being asked, no point will be given. (e.g. they tuck their shirt in without being told to do so).
- Any uniform infringement that cannot be rectified immediately, for example, trainers or coloured hair, will only receive 1 point for that day (or period of time until it can be rectified). The tutor or HOY will provide a note for the student for the rest of the day (or period of time until it can be rectified).
- Students with no uniform points in a day will be awarded an achievement point, coded D4S (Dressed for Success).

### Rewards

- Prize draw in tutor group weekly.
- Tutor group prize weekly for group at top of league.
- Half termly prize – breakfast provided for tutor group at top of league table in each year.

### Uniform rules

- Black trousers or pleated skirt.
- Shirt tucked in all the way around.
- Blazer, Tie, Lanyard.
- School jumper may be worn under blazer – no hoodies or branded sportswear.
- No visible jewellery (except for a watch and one pair of stud earrings).
- Nails: no false or brightly coloured nails.
- Eyelashes: no false eyelashes.
- Formal black school shoes.
- No extreme hair colouration.
